Can I create a forum in Moodle where my students reply and participate in the discussion anonymously?

***Important: This feature is only available in the Advanced forum  and not in the "standard" Moodle Forum .

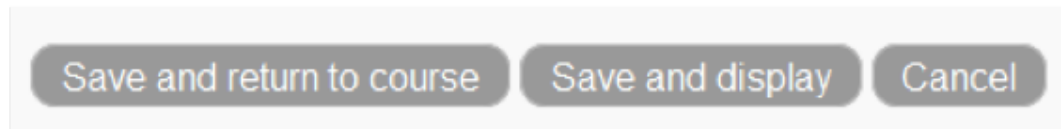
Yes, as an instructor you may enable anonymous replies for all participants in a discussion forum when you establish the settings of an Advanced Forum activity. If enabled, then the author's name for each post will be suppressed when viewing the forum.

Prepare:

Anonymous Discussion Forums

1. When creating or editing the forum, the selection is available in **Post options** section of the settings.
2. Select the check box for **Allow anonymous posting**.
3. Continue to edit settings as needed and choose the appropriate **Save/Cancel** action.
